Farewell Christina

We at BFO are so grateful for how God has moved in many miraculous ways beyond our imagination to provide physical strength after the tragic loss of one of our first teenagers, a young mother whom we took into the care centre. Late Christina passed away on the 11th of June and has gone to be with the LORD. She died with an encouraging testimony as she saw Heaven's Door opening to welcome her! Christina's wish was for BFO to look after her fatherless little boys, Thomas (4) and Manuku (3). The funeral service was very touching! At the service I spoke up and said, "Upon late Christina's death and in the presence of the coffin holding her body, on her behalf we forgive those who have sexually assaulted and abused her before her death." There is guilt among the people who knew her. There is joy in hearing God's Call and knowing God is changing hearts and that Christina is with God now in Heaven.

Though we don't have permanent buildings/houses for the children to call their home, they are always thankful with the little space provided for laying their heads for a night. We encourage ourselves that God has never forgotten us and in His timing He will provide us a home. We are expecting a better place one day!

Water is a major problem where we live. The small creek, which the children use for washing clothes and showering, is now used as a dumping area. The place is really a health hazard. A 9000 litre water tank is immediately needed. This may not be enough due to our limited space, but it is much better than the children drinking and washing from the dirty creek. The GOOD LORD has blessed them with good health even though our living condition is very poor!

Physically & Spiritually Blessed

In June there was enough food supplied for each home of the widows with children together with the schedule feeds at the usual BFO Site. The well-established Christian Mission Impossible in Sydney has delivered food such as rice, noodles and sugar for two months through its PNG Director Abraham. Also the women and children from Eagle Ministry in Mt Hagen donated clothes and sleeping mats. Our constant supporters, Mission Aviation Fellowship continue to bless us with clothing, fresh fish and coconuts.

We were also showered with spiritual blessings from Heaven. These months were special, as children surrendered their lives to God to change from their bad ways to the Christian life style. It happened when I was reading from Romans 6:23 about the wages of sin being death. The area in which we operate has been well known for crimes of killing, rape and creating illicit drinks and markets. Some children are being forced to take part as we live very close to the people who still practice these illicit deeds to make their living. God dealt with each child on personal convictions of wrongs. Many confessed aloud their sins and committed their lives to God.

“But those who hope in the LORD shall renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint.” Isaiah 40: 31
