A young abandoned girl came to us with a genuine note to offer her help in mending the children's torn clothes and cleaning at the Orphanage. After completing grade 10 about ten years ago Davina has since lived off the streets. This history was outlined in her brief introductory letter. Her note is only the 'tip of the iceberg' in the reality of her life.

Currently, Davina's performances demonstrate her genuine heart to the special ministry. BFO will endeavour to give her a good future in training her and others in life skills.

Recovering Family

So many children are continuing to come to BFO for help. Sammy Yamo, who is six years old was picked up from our general hospital by Cathy, who believed him to be her grandson. When Cathy heard about BFO, Sammy and his eight-year-old brother Jarred Daniel (pictured below) were brought in. There is also another brother Jordan who was sold by their mother for K700 (approx AUD\$300) to a couple from one of the main mining areas of PNG, the Porgera Gold mine. Their birth parents have gone their own ways! The mother remarried and the father is drug addicted. Cathy is the boys' grandmother. She is a very faithful and committed Christian. She does not have a job to support both Jarred Daniel and Sammy Yamo. It was with a broken heart that she walked into BFO to offer her assistance in sewing to give a future to these small boys. After some careful investigation Cathy has found that the couple who purchased Jordan were killed in a tribal fight. Little Jordan is currently living in another province, Enga. Jordan was only 4 years old, when his mother sold him. We are hoping to bring him to BFO in the near future.



There is always revival in the humble garage where we have our breakfast, dinner, prayer and bible study along with community meetings. We are looking forward to the new month June, by trusting God Alone!
